11. **RESOLUTION TO THE U.S. COOL COUNTIES CLIMATE STABILIZATION PROGRAM**

By letter dated January 29, 2008, Community Development Agency Director Alex Hinds and Planning Aide Omar Pena submitted their report and recommendations regarding the above-captioned matter.

Mr. Hinds thanked the Board and acknowledged Mr. Pena for pursuing this resolution to join the U.S. Cool Counties climate Stabilization program.

Mr. Pena briefly commented on the resolution and noted that by signing the resolution Marin County would pledge to reduce global warming emissions 80% below current levels by 2050.

Supervisor Adams thanked staff for bringing the cool climate resolution forward and for developing the sustainability website.
